KING COUNTY | ABCD DENTAL PROGRAM CAN HELP.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

- Children, birth through age 5
- Children with a Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) indicator thorough age twelve
- Living in King County

#### WHAT THIS PROGRAM DOES:

- Helps you find a dentist
- Gives your children a great start in life by making sure baby teeth are healthy
- Gets children into a dentist as early as age one, as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry
- Provides an easy exam with child in parent's arms, not in a dental chair
- Prevents tooth pain later on in life

#### **DENTAL BENEFITS:**

- 3 fluoride varnish applications yearly
- 2 dental exams yearly
- 2 parent education sessions per child yearly
- Restorative care as needed
